The workshop aims to provide researchers with a forum for presenting and discussing research on gender economics.

Both theoretical and empirical papers are welcome. Preference will be given, conditional on quality, to authors who have not presented in the last meeting. The workshop will include about 10 presentations. The keynote speakers will be **Manuel Bagues** (University of Warwick) and **Ghazala Azmat** (Sciences Po).
